Freedom Session

Freedom Session is a 20 week (or 30 week) intensive healing-discipleship journey that uncovers the roots of pain in our lives and invites Jesus Christ to heal those areas of our hearts. Freedom Session deals with real issues... pornography, broken marriages, sexual woundedness and abuse, depression, anger, fear and addiction. Beneath these, you will find a wounded and empty heart, looking for hope and meaning. As Jesus begins to heal the heart, the unhealthy and destructive ways we used to escape the pain in our lives become less and less attractive. Shame loses its grip on our lives and the lies that controlled us are replaced by God's truth.

Follow-up Seminars

If you are interested in a follow-up seminar that presents the hope and help that Jesus offers to people who experience same-sex attractions, and equips Christians and churches to minister the truth and grace of Jesus, Exodus Global Alliance presents a seminar called Sexuality, Truth and Grace.

The seminar can have a ministry focus or an equipping focus or both.

The core messages of the seminar include:

Personal messages

- The Gospel is good news to people impacted by sexual/relational brokenness. God wants these men and women to be part of His family.
- God loves people impacted by sexual/relational brokenness people. He offers the same salvation, hope & help as He offers to everyone else. God will meet you at your point of need.
- God does not overlook our faults or our struggles with sexuality; rather He looks through them, knowing that our deepest need is for a vital relationship with Him, seeing what we become in Jesus. He also knows that "apart from Him we can do nothing." When the Holy Spirit begins to take residence in your life, He transforms and empowers you to live in agreement with His Word.
- Transformation & change is such an integral part of Christian life that Scriptures describe Christian life as being born again, becoming a new creation and changing from being dead to alive. The primary goal God has for believers, including those with same-sex attractions, is to have an intimate relationship with Christ and develop a capacity for living with integrity in Christ. In other words, the change God wants in believers who experience same-sex attractions is Spirit-empowered living.
- Having a personal relationship with Jesus Christ does not mean our struggles with relational or sexual brokenness simply disappear. Nor does it mean same-sex attractions (or other sexual temptations) simply disappear. But Spirit-empowered living does mean that God leads us through a number of changes in our lives. Most change and transformation occurs within a process that requires time, healthy relationships, regular participation in a local church and co-operation with God in His transformation process.

Church messages

- Our church has families & individuals who experience sexual brokenness (e.g. porn, gender confusion, sexual abuse, promiscuity) making us a church of wounded people.
- Our church is called to be a safe place for wounded people, for questioning people, for growing people to experience God's presence, fellowship, discipleship, worship. There is a place here in our church for people impacted by sexual/relational brokenness. We want you here.
- Our church helps people find hope and live life through experiencing Jesus in their relationships and sexuality.
- God uses the people in our church to minister God's truth & grace to one another.
